background to the unique needs of clients proposing and developing renewable and other types of green energy projects.

DeCotiis has also developed, structured and created the first local government renewable energy program for local governments in New Jersey. The program is being implemented in New Jersey counties, and will allow local governments to finance renewable energy projects at a lower operating cost, resulting in direct, certain budgetary savings, while achieving the environmental benefits of employing green technology. It is currently being expanded to the private sector.

Similarly, the Green practice's expertise is applicable to environmentally advanced construction and development projects in which, for example, Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED), the Federal Energy Star Program and carbon footprint reduction are issues that require resolution.
