served as Legislative Assistant to the Chairman of the New Jersey General Assembly Committee on Taxation and in the same capacity to the Vice Chairman of the Senate Appropriations Committee. He served as Director of Law for the City of Rahway for nine years, from 1991 to 2000, as well as from 2007 to the present.
